MEPA is designed to provide a comprehensive update in paediatric anaesthesia and resuscitation. Participants will develop management strategies for dealing with emergencies in paediatric anaesthesia. The course is a one day interactive program utilising medium and high fidelity simulation, and using expert peer-reviewed scenarios. It is an opportunity to gain knowledge, share experiences and practice skills.

Demonstrate competency in newborn and paediatric resuscitation.
 Develop and demonstrate effective management of common and serious emergencies in paediatric anaesthesia.
 Develop skills in effective team leadership, team work and communication during emergencies.
