Sydney Trains will be undertaking maintenance work at Westmead from Friday 20 April to Monday 23 April.

To improve service reliability and reduce the need for ongoing maintenance we're working on track reconditioning.

We understand that this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend. We apologise for the inconvenience this may cause.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 7am Friday 20 April to 5pm Monday 23 April.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside of this time.
- Due to travel restrictions on large vehicles, some of these deliveries may need to take place at night.
- Please note diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Road Closures

- Work vehicles will access the rail corridor via Hawkesbury Road Overbridge and Railway Parade, Westmead.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor wherever possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- **A single lane on Hawkesbury Road will be closed from 7am Friday 20 April to 5pm Monday 23 April.**
- **Parking and a single lane of traffic will be impacted on Railway Parade between 7am Friday 20 April to 5pm Monday 23 April.**
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to direct motorists throughout the duration of the works.
