

Caring for the Surgical Neonate Study Day

Offered twice a year



The Study Day is designed for registered nurses new to the neonatal surgical setting or who have an interest in working with surgical neonates.

Sessions in the day cover:

- Antenatal diagnosis, delivery and initial stabilisation for infants requiring surgery
- Preparation for neonatal anaesthesia and surgery including post-operative care
- X-ray interpretation in the surgical neonate
- Pain assessment and management
- Nutritional and feeding requirements for post-surgical neonates
- Supporting the neonate and family to reach behavioural and developmental criteria
- Outcomes for infants undergoing neonatal surgery
- Clinical Case Studies

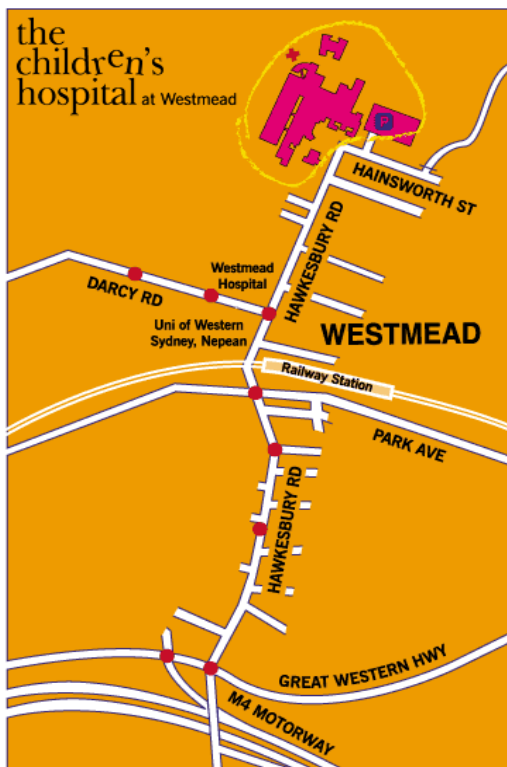

CHW Location and Parking:

The Hospital is only minutes from the major centre of Parramatta, and about 35 minutes by train from Sydney city. Public transport to The Children's Hospital at Westmead is easy, with direct bus and train services, and connecting bus, train and ferry services from the city, Parramatta, Strathfield, Penrith and the North Shore.



Paid Parking:

At CHW a multi-level parking complex is located on Hainsworth Street with entrance at the roundabout. The fee is determined at the auto pay station prior to returning to your vehicle. The cost for > 5hours is \$17.

Westmead Hospital is nearby and a multistorey complex is located on the corner of Hawkesbury and Darcy Rd's (entry via both roads), cost \$7 per day coins only.

Old University of Western Sydney (nearby campus) - open air parking located corner of Hawkesbury & Darcy Rd (entry via Hawkesbury Rd), >\$8 per day coins only.

Free Parking:

Most street parking is limited to two hours and is available on: Hawkesbury Rd, Helen St, Jessie St, Caroline St & Hainsworth St.
